Miller, who currently lives in Hollywood, recently finished his first professional EP with Grammy-winning producer Jack Douglas (John Lennon, Aerosmith, Cheap Trick) that was released in early 2007.

His music offers a fresh new sound and his high-energy performances have turned heads and attracted audiences from New York to Rome.

Miller grew up in Hampton Roads and started playing guitar at age 11. His performances started while he attended American University in Washington D.C. In 2005, fresh out of college, Miller took to the road playing shows in eight states on the East Coast. He further expanded his musical prowess that year by playing bass for a touring DC-based rock band, and subsequently formed the band, Maverick, for which he sang lead and played lead guitar. Subsequent journeys have taken him to Rome, where he gained a substantial following.
